Thus, CPC reported an operating loss of 104 billion rupees in 2018, compared to a profit of 3.4 billion rupees in 2017. The depreciation of the rupee against the U.S. dollar resulted in a loss of RS 82.7 billion rupees during 2018, while lower demand from the electricity sector also contributed to a decline in CPC revenues. Despite the notable increase in CPC rupee deposits in state-owned banks, from 5.0 billion rupees at the end of 2017 to 67.9 billion rupees at the end of 2018, total gross liabilities to the banking sector increased by 116.2 billion rupees to 293.2 billion rupees during the year, largely reflecting the impact of U.S. dollar borrowing on KTC. In addition, cpc's outstanding trade receivables to government agencies decreased by 10.4 billion rupees in 2018 to 81.7 billion rupees compared to 2017. As of the end of 2018, CEB and SriLankan Airlines (SLA) account for 58.3% and 31.3%, respectively, of CPC's total trade receivables. The Central Bank said that the financial performance of the Central Bank in 2018 remained weak. Although hydropower has improved significantly during 2018, this was not enough to offset the losses incurred due to the high cost of thermal generation. According to the unaudited preliminary financial statements, the Central Bank recorded a pre-tax loss of 28.9 billion rupees in 2018, compared to a loss of 46.0 billion rupees in 2017. The low demand for fuel oil for electricity generation, due to the increased availability of hydropower, significantly reduced the cost of EBB for fuel by 28.2%, to 41.6 billion rupees in 2018. Thus, the total average cost of electricity at the point of sale decreased to 19.13 euros per kWh in 2018, compared to EUR 20.06 per kWh in 2017, while the total average tariff at the end of December 2018 was 16.30 euros per kWh compared to 16.49 rupees per kWh previously. Although the average cost of electricity at the time of sale decreased during the year, it remained above the overall average tariff that the need to pricing for reflective costs in this sector. By the end of 2018, average electricity tariffs CEB domestic, general purpose, state, industrial and hotel sectors - 13.60 rupees, 23.78 rupees, 18.24 rupees, 14.72 and 17.61 rupees per kWh, respectively. Meanwhile, the central bank's short-term liabilities, primarily to the banking sector, CPC and WFP, increased to 141.1 billion rupees by the end of 2018 from 138.0 billion rupees at the end of 2017. The Central Bank's long-term liabilities, mainly to the banking sector, increased to 392.2 billion rupees at the end of 2018 from 319.6 billion rupees at the end of 2017. The weak financial position of the CEB and the heavy burden it puts on the balance sheet of state banks underscore the need to implement plans to expand electricity generation from less expensive sources without delay, in addition to the urgent need to introduce a cost-generating electricity pricing mechanism.
